



Notice of Race

Moonlight and Mimosas Regatta 2006

Continuing the tradition of a race in the moonlight from Oriental to Bath

Organized by: Pamlico Sailing Club

Date: August 12th & 13th, 2006

Racing Area: Course will begin between the committee boat and the **FI G 4s "1"** navigation mark off Oriental in the Neuse River. Course will end between the committee boat and Core Point mark **FI G 4s "5"** off Bath in the Pamlico River. Leave Neuse River mark **FI 6s "NR" (35° 06' 38"N, 076° 28' 31"W)** to starboard, Brant Island Shoal mark **"BI"** and Pamlico Point mark **"PP"** to port, and leave Indian Island mark **G "3"** to starboard while enroute.

Unless modified by the Race Committee on the day of the race, there will be a single start for all classes. First warning signal will be at 3:00 PM.

Skippers Meeting: 1:00 PM, Saturday August 12th, Oriental Town Dock

Eligibility: Any vessel having a valid NC-PHRF certificate, or having a provisional rating assigned by the race organizers, may register. Classes will be spinnaker and non-spinnaker. Classes may be divided into divisions based on the number of boats entered.

Entry Form, Fees: Entry fee of \$30 per boat which includes Sunday brunch and beverages for all crew. A registration form will be distributed with this invitation, or can be downloaded from the PSC website at: <http://www.sailingsource.com/psc/>.

Safety: All vessels must comply with USCG safety requirements. Racing may be cancelled with sustained winds in excess of 25 knots or in the event of a tropical storm warning given by NOAA.

Social/Brunch: Upon completion of the racing on Saturday night, boats should proceed to the State Docks in Bath or to the Bath Harbor Marina. Brunch, including mimosas and screwdrivers, will be provided at 9:00 am in the shelter at Bath Harbor Marina. Awards will be presented after breakfast.

Trophies: Trophies will be presented to the top 3 finishers in each class having 5 boats registered, and top 2 in classes with fewer than 5 boats.
