You are invited to participate in the 4th Pamlico Cup Hospice Regatta, which will take place in Bath, NC during the third weekend in October. Sponsored by Pamlico Cup Hospice Regatta, Inc., the regatta is an annual event that has raised over \$17,500 for local hospice groups. The beneficiary of the 2006 regatta is Edgecombe Home Care and Hospice, which provides care and support to terminally ill patients, and to their families, in Eastern North Carolina.

The objectives of the Pamlico Cup Hospice Regatta, one of 25 Hospice Regattas held nationally, are: to provide a great race and party that brings in sailors for good competition, to conduct an event that draws contributions from sponsors and spectators, and to build community awareness about hospice.

You contribute to the cause by coming out to race, watch, or join the party.

Here's a part of what we have planned for the Pamlico Cup Hospice Regatta:

- **A Sailor's Reception and Barbeque with entertainment on Friday Evening**
- **Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday**
- **Racing in the Pamlico on Saturday and Sunday– run by officials from US Sailing**
- **A Dinner and Dance on Saturday Evening**
- **A special *Cruising Class* for sailors who don't usually race, and a *Party Class* for sailors and power boaters who want to motor around the course while watching**
- **A flotilla of spectator boats will encourage sponsors and family to watch the racing**
- **Your \$85 entry fee includes a souvenir tee shirt and a ticket for the shoreside events**
- **If you register early, your boat name will be printed on your tee shirt.**

Your real prize for participating in the Pamlico Cup is your contribution to a good cause, but we'll be awarding trophies in each class. **The overall winner of the Pamlico Cup Hospice Regatta will race against the winners of the other 24 hospice regattas during the National Hospice Regatta Championship in Annapolis, MD in the spring of 2007.** Transportation costs and lodging will be subsidized for the winner and his crew, who will be racing on a J/105 provided by the National Hospice Regatta Alliance.
