1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the PHRF class. The organizing authority reserves the right to reassign entries to different classes. Individual starts will be given to the following classes (a minimum of 4 boats is required to constitute a class):

Class 1 Spinnaker

Class 2 Jib & Main

Class 3 Cruising (In accordance with current ICRC intent, the purpose of this class is to encourage less experienced sailors to get involved, and it is those who should register herein).

Class 4 PHRF 240+ (PHRF rating subject to modification by RC)

2.2 An entry form is part of this NOR.

3 FEES

3.1 The REGISTRATION fee is \$50.00 when accompanying the completed Entry Form and submitted or postmarked by July 28th.

3.2 The LATE REGISTRATION fee is \$65.00 when accompanying the completed Entry Form submitted or postmarked after July 28th. LATE REGISTRATION will be accepted on the deck of the Oriental Marina and Inn (OM&I) 1800 to 2000 Friday August 6th, and 0730 to 0830 Saturday August 7th.

3.3 You may avoid LATE REGISTRATION by calling or e-mailing your intent to race including all information required on the Entry form by July 28th, and presenting the completed documents to the LATE REGISTRATION desk prior to 0830 on Saturday. 3.4 US Sailing members are eligible for a \$5.00 discount if their member # is on the entry form.

3.5 Saturday dinner tickets are available for \$15.00 each with REGISTRATION. Saturday dinner tickets are available after July 28th for \$17.00 each. All dinner tickets must be purchased by 0830 Saturday.

4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Dates of Racing: August 7 & 8, 2010

4.2 A Skipper's Meeting will be held at 0900 on Saturday on the deck at the OM&I.

4.3 Number of races: We will attempt to hold three races; preferably two on Saturday and one on Sunday. One race will constitute a regatta.

4.4 The time of the first warning signal for the first race on Saturday is 1100. The first warning signal on Sunday will be at 1000. Warning signals for a second race of the day will be at the discretion of the Race Committee.

4.5 On Saturday there will be a cash bar social at the Tiki Bar at the OM&I following racing, with a Steak & Shrimp dinner on the grounds of the OM&I at 1800.

4.6 Awards will be presented after racing on Sunday at approximately 1400 on the deck of the OM&I.

5 RATING CERTIFICATE

Each boat registering in the Spinnaker or Jib & Main class, and not listed in the current NCPHRF Yearbook, shall submit a copy of a current NCPHRF rating certificate with the registration documents. Those without a valid NCPHRF rating certificate will be assigned one by ODC for purposes of this regatta, and the additional \$15 fee will be submitted to NCPHRF for registration.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on the ODC website by August 1st. Copies of the sailing instructions will be available at the LATE REGISTRATION desk after 1800 on Friday August 6th and will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board at OM&I.

7 VENUE

7.1 Regatta headquarters will be on the deck of the Oriental Marina and Inn (OM&I) on the harbor in Oriental NC. The races will be held in the waters off of Oriental NC.

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be triangular or windward/leeward and will be posted on the signal boat. "W" is windward/leeward and "T" is triangle. The number of LEGS will be indicated after the W or T. "T3" is a 3 leg triangle. Diagrams will be included in the sailing instructions. Inflatable tetrahedrons will be used as marks and will all be left to port.

9 SCORING

9.1 The classes may be divided into divisions, for regatta scoring purposes only, depending on the number of entries (a minimum of 4 boats is required to constitute a division). All races scored will be included in a boat's series position. ICRC will only score the 4 Classes.

10 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be identified at the Skippers Meeting.

11 DOCK SPACE

Dock space may be available at the OM&I (252-249-1818). Dock space may be available at Whittaker Pointe Marina, Ashley Erwin (252-675-2554). Transportation to town is necessary from this marina. ODC can arrange.

12 PRIZES

Up to three trophies will be awarded to each class or division depending on the number of entries. The season ICRC trophy will be awarded to the club with the best season score.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See *RRS* rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14 INSURANCE

Entry into this regatta certifies by the owner that the participating yacht is insured with current third-party liability insurance.
