

2010 San Juan 21 Fall Sunday Series



Sundays starting September 26 through November 14, 2010

NOTICE OF RACE:

Come join members of San Juan 21 Fleet 8, Blackbeard Sailing Club and NYRA to promote one-design racing and sailing on the upper Neuse River.

Blackbeard Sailing Club will host and sponsor the event for the San Juan 21 sailors.

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in "The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012" with the following additions:

-Racing Rule 26 (Starting Races). The "P" flag will be used for the Preparatory Signal.

A three minute starting sequence will be utilized.

The San Juan 21's will race on Broad Creek in the vicinity of Blackbeard Sailing Club.

For each sailing date:

10:00am - First sequence begins. One or more races to follow based on conditions with three races anticipated. Each race will be approximately 30 to 45 minutes in length, with the intention to complete all racing by 12:30pm, no races will be started after 12:00 pm

There will be eight sailing dates for a total of 24 races scheduled for the series. The dates are as follows:

September 26, October 3, October 10, October 17, October 24, October 31, November 7, November 14.

Results from competitors best five dates will be counted towards the series scoring. There will be no make up dates for any cancelled races.

Race organizers will try their best to secure a steady volunteer race committee to support this event. Should we not be able to get volunteers to support a given weekend, we will ask for volunteers from the class to act as RC for a maximum of one weekend each should it be needed. If needed, the boat who accepts this task will receive average points based on his/her overall series finishes as scores for that day. Everything required to run the race committee duties will be provided.

Sailing Instructions will be available at the skippers' meeting to be held on September 26, 2010 at approx 9:00 am at Blackbeard Sailing Club.

Classes will include spin and non spin. All classes will start together unless sufficient participation allows for individual class starts.

Declaration of either spin or non spin must be made at the time of registration. Once a class declaration is made changes can only be made with approval from the organizing group.

Awards will be determined based on a creative evaluation on how best to recognize the participants. The Fall Series awards will be handed out at the NC State Championships / Turkey Trot regatta on Saturday, November 20.

Registration is FREE for 2010 - donations will be accepted to be used towards appropriate awards for the series
