



**NOTICE OF RACE  
Winter Series 2010-2011  
Including the Halloween Regatta  
Neuse Yacht Racing Association**

**LOCATION**

Races will be held in the vicinity of Neuse River markers #17 and #19 and Broad Creek #2 near New Bern, NC.

**RULES**

The regatta and series will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing.

**ELIGIBILITY**

Entries shall be accepted from skippers of mono-hull sailboats 21 feet or longer with a current NC PHRF rating certificate. Eligible boats may enter by sending the completed entry form and required fee to the address given. Anticipated classes are **spinnaker, non-spinnaker, and cruising.**

**SCHEDULE**

Six racing days are scheduled for the NYRA WINTER SERIES

The **First Warning Signal** for all race days is scheduled at **10:55am.**

**Socials** will begin about **5:00pm** on every race day, even if racing is canceled. The social location will be announced on the NYRA website. <http://www.nyra.org/>

**SKIPPER'S MEETING**

The only skippers' meeting for the series and Halloween Regatta will be held **Oct. 30 at 9:00am** at Northwest Creek Marina. Sailing Instructions will be available at the skippers meeting and on the NYRA website.

**SCORING AND HANDICAPS**

The **Low Point System** will be used for scoring. Appendix A2 is modified as follows; when 5 or more races are completed the worst score will be excluded, if 9 or more races are completed the worst 2 scores will be excluded. Handicapping will be **Time on Time** with a correction factor of  $650/(550+PHRF)$ .

**One completed race will constitute a series or regatta.**

**AWARDS**

There will be approximately one award given for every three boats entered in each class. Awards for the Halloween Regatta will be presented at the social following the race. Winter Series awards will be presented at the 2011 Commodores Ball.

**RACE COMMITTEE**

The PRO for this series will be Bill Jarvis. If sufficient volunteers are not available, the boats competing will be asked to provide race committee helpers.

Racing shall be canceled on any day the real feel temperature is forecast to be at or below 35 degrees. The determination will be made based on the noon forecast on [www.accuweather.com](http://www.accuweather.com) the day before the race and will be posted on the NYRA website. Racing shall also be canceled when the wind speed is above 25 knots sustained before the start of a race
